



# FIRST CONTACTS: First Peoples and European Settlers

(Grade 5)

This guide will assist you in finding information in the Memorial (Alliston), D.A. Jones (Beeton), and Pam Kirkpatrick (Tottenham) branches of the New Tecumseth Public Library (NTPL) and on the Internet.

When searching the NTPL catalogue, ([www.ntpl.ca](http://www.ntpl.ca)), use the subject heading **New France** and/or **first contacts** and/or **first peoples**. Subject searches can also be done by specific tribe name (e.g. **Iroquois**).

When searching the Internet (try [www.google.ca](http://www.google.ca)), use the keywords **"native peoples" Canada** and/or **"explorers" Canada**. Be sure to include the quotation marks.
